

Counties of Utah Reports



We will be starting to gather information this week for our reports on the counties in Utah. You can choose what you want to do for these reports, but they must include the following information:

- Where is your county located in Utah? (What are some other counties near it? Is it on the east or west side of Utah? etc.)
- What is the capital of your county?
- What are 2 other main cities/towns in your county?
- What kind of terrain is found in your county? (Is it mainly a desert? Is most of your county a mountain?)
- What are some fun things to go do, visit, or see in your county? (Are there any National Parks? Is there a lake to swim in? Is it a good place to go skiing?)
- What is the elevation of the county?
- What are two companies that offer employment to people in your county and what do they do? (farming, mining, Adobe, etc.)
- What is a special event that takes place in your county? (Swiss Days, Iron County Rodeo, Freedom Festival, etc.)
- What is the population of your county?
- What is the average climate of your county? (What are some average temperatures in the spring, summer, fall, & winter? What is the average precipitation for the year?)
- At least three other interesting things you want to tell your classmates about your county.

Some options for your county report could include:

- Make a poster showing things about your county
- Write a paper about your county
- Give an oral report of your county (make sure you talk about all the things you need to still!)
- Draw a picture of a cool place to visit in your county and write all the information on the back.
- Talk to Mrs. Strock to get any other project approved. (It will probably be fine, just check with me first)
